

CPD LLANGEFNI TOWN FC

Llangefni Town were founder members of the Anglesey Football League back in 1897, but according to archive records, they show there was a team in the Town in 1892, but this was primarily a Chapel based team. They played in it with some distinction for many years winning the League title six times as well as winning the Dargie Cup twice, and the Megan Cup once and the reserves picking up the North Wales Coast Junior Cup.

Many years later, in 1991 the club accepted promotion into the then Tyn Lon Volvo Welsh Alliance League where they won the League Championship, the Barritt and Alves Cups. They then went on to win the Barritt Cup after treble success in the competition in 1991, 1992 and again in 1993. Llangefni also became the only Anglesey club to have ever won the Welsh Intermediate Cup back in 1992. They also won the Cookson Cup in 1994 and also won the Welsh Alliance League Championship four times between 1991 and 1999.

In 1999 the club moved from Isgraig to its current ground at Talwrn Road. 2007 saw the club gain promotion to the Welsh Premier League fulfilling the club's ambitions of the past 10 years, but that was short lived. In 2010, against the odds the club won the Cymru Alliance league championship again, only to be denied promotion to the reorganised Premier League for failure to gain a Domestic Licence.

After a string of managers and indifferent seasons the 2014 season saw Llangefni pull out of the Welsh Alliance, 2014/2015, saw current manager Chris Roberts take charge of the first team he built a team made up of local boys, they were re-instated in the Welsh Alliance 2nd Division, and ended up in second place earning promotion to the First Division. 2015/2016 season, the goal was to finish in the Top 5 but the team ended up in Third position, exceeding all ambitions. 2016/17 the club finished second in the league and narrowly missed out on promotion by goals scored. The 2017/18 season was very much the same as the previous 2 seasons in the 1st division of the Welsh Alliance, once again narrowly missed out on promotion this time finishing second, 3 points behind champions Conwy Borough.

In the 2018/19 season the side won the Welsh Alliance Division for the record 5th time and achieved promotion to the newly formed Cymru North. In a very successful season, the team reached 2 finals, winning the Cookson Cup.

The clubs return to tier 2 for the 2019/20 season was cut short due to the Covid-19 pandemic.





BUCKLEY TOWN FOOTBALL CLUB GROUND REGULATIONS, THE GLOBE, GLOBE WAY, BUCKLEY

Notwithstanding possession of any ticket the Club, any police officer or authorised steward may refuse entry to (or eject from) the Ground any person that fails (or in the Club's reasonable opinion is likely to fail) to comply with these Ground Regulations and/or the Discrimination Commitment and/or the Supporter Code of Conduct and/or any reasonable instruction issued by a police officer or authorised steward or officer of the Club; and/or whose presence within the Ground is, or could (in the Club's reasonable opinion), constitute a source of danger, nuisance or annoyance to any other person.

In the event of the postponement or abandonment of the Match, refunds (if any) will be made in accordance with the Club's terms and conditions of entry. The Club will have no further liability whatsoever, including (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, such as (but not limited to) loss of enjoyment or travel costs. All persons seeking entrance to the Ground acknowledge the Club's right to search any person entering the Ground and to refuse entry to or eject from the Ground any person refusing to submit to such a search. The following articles must not be brought within the Ground: knives, fireworks, smoke canisters, air-horns, flares, weapons, dangerous or hazardous items, laser devices, bottles, glass vessels, cans, poles and any article that might be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety. Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry to the Ground. Further, you may not bring into the Ground any sponsorship, promotional or marketing materials save in respect of official club merchandise and/or other football related clothing worn in good faith; any flags or banners larger than those maximum dimensions permitted by the Club from time to time (or, in the absence of such stipulations, 2 metres x 1 metre) and/or of an offensive nature; nor may you offer (either free or for sale by any person) any goods (including literature) of any nature, without the express written approval of the Club's management. The use of threatening behaviour, foul or abusive language is strictly forbidden and will result in arrest and/or ejection from the Ground. The following acts are offences under the Football (Offences) Act 1991 (as amended): 12.1 The throwing of any object within the Ground will authority or excuse. 12.2 The chanting of anything of an indecent or racialist nature. 12.3 The entry onto the playing area or any adjacent area to which spectators are not generally admitted without lawful authority or excuse. Conviction may result in a Banning Order being made. Nobody m

The Globe and surrounding areas are smoke-free and smoking or the use of electronic cigarettes is not permitted inside the Ground.

Mobile telephones and other mobile devices are permitted within the Ground PROVIDED THAT (i) they are used for personal and private use only (which, for the avoidance of doubt and by way of example only, shall not include the capturing, logging, recording, transmitting, playing, issuing, showing, or any other communication of any Material for any commercial purposes); and (ii) no Material that is captured, logged, recorded, transmitted, played, issued, shown or otherwise communicated by a mobile telephone or other mobile device may be published or otherwise made available to any third parties including, without limitation, via social networking sites. No person (other than a person who holds an appropriate licence or has been given specific permissions) may capture, log, record, transmit, play, issue, show or otherwise communicate (by digital or other means) any Material in relation to the Match, any players or other persons present in the Ground and/or the Ground, nor may they bring into the Ground or use within the Ground (or provide to, facilitate or otherwise assist another person to use within the Ground) any equipment or technology which is capable of capturing, logging, recording, transmitting, playing, issuing, showing or otherwise communicating (by digital or other means) any such Material. The copyright, database rights and any other intellectual property rights in and to all Material that you produce at the Ground in relation to the Match, any players or other persons present in the Ground and/or the Ground is hereby assigned (including by way of present assignment of future copyright pursuant to section 91 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988) to the Club and the FAW. You further agree (if and whenever required to do so by the Club and/or the FAW) to promptly execute all instruments and do all things necessary to vest the right, title and interest in such rights to the Club and the FAW absolutely and with full title guarantee.

CCTV cameras are in use around and in the Ground; video and/or audio may also be used as appropriate, to record images or audio which identifies you as an individual, for example to record prohibited behaviours as referenced in paragraphs above. The Club may itself use or pass to the police or any Football Authority or other clubs, any recordings for use in any proceedings. By entering the Ground, all persons are acknowledging that photographic images and/or audio, visual and/or audio-visual recordings and/or feeds (and/or stills taken therefrom) may be taken of them and may also be used, by way of example and without limitation, in televised coverage of the game and/or for promotional, training, editorial or marketing purposes by the Club, the FAW or others (including commercial partners and accredited media organisations) and entry into the Ground constitutes consent to such use. You further acknowledge that photographic images and/or audio, visual and/or audio-visual recordings and/or feeds (and/or stills taken therefrom) may be used (by the Club or by a third party, such as a law enforcement body) to identify you as an individual, where permitted by data protection laws, for the purposes of preventing or detecting crime, or any breach of these Ground Regulations. Information about the Club's use of your personal data will be brought to your attention by the Club (see for example any applicable privacy policy, signage and/or other forms of announcement in or around the ground). For further information please contact the Club. All ticket holders agree that the Matches for which the tickets have been purchased are public, and that their appearance and actions inside and in the perimeter of the Ground where a Match occurs are public in nature, and that they shall have no expectation of privacy with regard to their actions or conduct at Matches. If such person is under 18 years of age, the parent, guardian, or responsible adult who is accompanying them into the Ground shall be deemed to have provided consent on
