PRESTATYN TOWN

Football has been played in many guises in Prestatyn since the early 1890s. In 1930 the team we know today started playing at the old Bastion Road Ground. The early parts of the club's history are a bit sketchy until the leadership of the remarkable Sam Bennett. He didn't settle for just training and managing the team; he was often a linesman, head of the committee and also wrote the match reports.

For a brief period in the 1940s the Club was known as 'Chanydore FC' but quickly changed its name back. In the early 70s the club moved to Bastion Gardens and became founding members of The Clwyd Football League in 1974/75. They went on to win six titles and five cups, rejoining The Welsh Alliance.

The 1993/94 season brought moderate success as Alves Cup winners, finishing eigth in the league. In the following season PTFC won their last fourteen games to finish in second place, three points behind Rhydymwyn, also reaching the semi-final of The Alves Cup. They again finished runners-up the following season, this time to Denbigh Town. Rejoining the Clwyd League in 1998/99 PTFC won the League and Cup before rejoining the Welsh Alliance the following season and again winning the Alves Cup. They reached the final of The NWCFA Challenge Cup losing to Premier League opponents Bangor City and won the League in 2005/06, reaching the finals of both the Cal League Cup and NWCFA Challenge Cup.

2007/08 saw promotion and in 2012/13 PTFC won both the NWCFA Challenge Cup and also beat Bangor City in the final of The Welsh Cup. They were also the first Welsh club to make it to the second qualifying round of the Europa League on their first attempt, beating Latvian side Liepajas Metalurg before losing to Croatian side HNK Rijeka.

Their top flight stay ended in 2014/15, with promotion in 2016/17 before going back down. In 2018 there was a mass exodus of management and players, but the ship was steadied by the end of the season and they ended it six games unbeaten, including five wins, staying up. The 2019/20 season was looking very promising for Prestatyn as they were top of the league and looking forward to a Welsh Cup semi-final against TNS, but Covid-19 brought a premature end to the season. Despite being crowned Champions on a points per game basis, they were denied promotion due to their TV gantry not being up to standard.

Notwithstanding possession of any ticket the Club, any police officer or authorised steward may refuse entry to (or eject from) the Ground any person that fails (or in the Club's reasonable opinion is likely to fail) to comply with these Ground Regulations and/or the Discrimination Commitment and/or the Supporter Code of Conduct and/or any reasonable instruction issued by a police officer or authorised steward or officer of the Club; and/or whose presence within the Ground is, or could (in the Club's reasonable opinion), constitute a source of danger, nuisance or annoyance to any other person.

In the event of the postponement or abandonment of the Match, refunds (if any) will be made in accordance with the Club's terms and conditions of entry. The Club will have no further liability whatsoever, including (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, such as (but not limited to) loss of enjoyment or travel costs. All persons seeking entrance to the Ground acknowledge the Club's right to search any person entering the Ground and to refuse entry to or eject from the Ground any person refusing to submit to such a search. The following articles must not be brought within the Ground: knives, fireworks, smoke canisters, air-horns, flares, weapons, dangerous or hazardous items, laser devices, bottles, glass vessels, cans, poles and any article that might be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety. Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry to the Ground. Further, you may not bring into the Ground any sponsorship, promotional or marketing materials save in respect of official club merchandise and/or other football related clothing worn in good faith; any flags or banners larger than those maximum dimensions permitted by the Club from time to time (or, in the absence of such stipulations, 2 metres x 1 metre) and/or of an offensive nature; nor may you offer (either free or for sale by any person) any goods (including literature) of any nature, without the express written approval of the Club's management. The use of threatening behaviour, foul or abusive language is strictly forbidden and will result in arrest and/or ejection from the Ground. The following acts are offences under the Football (Offences) Act 1991 (as amended): 12.1 The throwing of any object within the Ground without lawful authority or excuse. 12.2 The chanting of anything of an indecent or racialist nature. 12.3 The entry onto the playing area or any adjacent area to which spectators are not generally admitted without lawful authority or excuse. Conviction may result in ejection from the Ground.

The Globe and surrounding areas are smoke-free and smoking or the use of electronic cigarettes is not permitted inside the Ground.

Mobile telephones and other mobile devices are permitted within the Ground PROVIDED THAT (i) they are used for personal and private use only (which, for the avoidance of doubt and by way of example only, shall not include the capturing, logging, recording, transmitting, playing, issuing, showing, or any other communication of any Material for any commercial purposes); and (ii) no Material that is captured, logged, recorded, transmitted, played, issued, shown or otherwise communicated by a mobile telephone or other mobile device may be published or otherwise made available to any third parties including, without limitation, via social networking sites. No person (other than a person who holds an appropriate licence or has been given specific permissions) may capture, log, record, transmit, play, issue, show or otherwise communicate (by digital or other means) any Material in relation to the Match, any players or other persons present in the Ground and/or the Ground, nor may they bring into the Ground or use within the Ground (or provide to, facilitate or otherwise assist another person to use within the Ground) any equipment or technology which is capable of capturing, logging, recording, transmitting, playing, issuing, showing or otherwise communicating (by digital or other means) any such Material. The copyright, database rights and any other intellectual property rights in and to all Material that you produce at the Ground in relation to the Match, any players or other persons present in the Ground and/or the Ground is hereby assigned (including by way of present assignment of future copyright pursuant to section 91 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988) to the Club and the FAW. You further agree (if and whenever required to do so by the Club and/or the FAW) to promptly execute all instruments and do all things necessary to vest the right, title and interest in such rights to the Club and the FAW absolutely and with full title guarantee.

CCTV cameras are in use around and in the Ground; video and/or audio may also be used as appropriate, to record images or audio which identifies you as an individual, for example to record prohibited behaviours as referenced in paragraphs above. The Club may itself use or pass to the police or any Football Authority or other clubs, any recordings for use in any proceedings. By entering the Ground, all persons are acknowledging that photographic images and/or audio, visual and/or audio-visual recordings and/or feeds (and/or stills taken therefrom) may be taken of them and may also be used, by way of example and without limitation, in televised coverage of the game and/or for promotional, training, editorial or marketing purposes by the Club, the FAW or others (including commercial partners and accredited media organisations) and entry into the Ground constitutes consent to such use. You further acknowledge that photographic images and/or audio, visual and/or audio-visual recordings and/or feeds (and/or stills taken therefrom) may be used (by the Club or by a third party, such as a law enforcement body) to identify you as an individual, where permitted by data protection laws, for the purposes of preventing or detecting crime, or any breach of these Ground Regulations. Information about the Club's use of your personal data will be brought to your attention by the Club (see for example any applicable privacy policy, signage and/or other forms of announcement in or around the ground). For further information please contact the Club. All ticket holders agree that the Matches for which the tickets have been purchased are public, and that their appearance and actions inside and in the perimeter of the Ground where a Match occurs are public in nature, and that they shall have no expectation of privacy with regard to their actions or conduct at Matches. If such person is under 18 years of age, the parent, guardian, or responsible adult who is accompanying them into the Ground shall be deemed to have provided consent on





Hey, how are you doing? We hope you're enjoying the match!

We'd like to introduce ourselves - we are Level Playing Field, the leading charity in England and Wales campaigning and advocating on behalf of disabled sports fans. Today, your club is using this match day to participate in our new national campaign, 'Unite For Access', a celebration of disabled fans, accessibility, and inclusion at sports venues.

Did you know that an estimated 22% of the UK population is disabled?

Talking of barriers, Level Playing Field conducted a survey last year which found that nearly 29% of disabled fans considered the 'attitudes of others' to be a barrier when attending live sports.

We appreciate that talking about disability can be daunting sometimes, it's a complex subject. That's why we invite all supporters, disabled and non-disabled, to engage with your Club, the Disabled Supporters Association (DSA) if it has one, and ourselves, because it's not just down to disabled people to highlight the importance of access and inclusion at your club.
